 - ▶ MANAGEMENT
- ▶ Document each step, monitor, remain
- ▶ Be very precise and disciplined in term of management, especially financial management. Collect all papers timely.
- ▶ If you depend on governmental or management bodies, be tactic and try to animate them to be devoted to the project.
- ▶ Try to oversee sustainability from the beginning of the project, especially sustainability via dissemination.

- Be honest and when have problems do not hesitate to ask
- Many jobs can be done ad-hock...
- Be good with policy makers or stakeholders and try to attract them
- Have in mind behavioral of each country, each education system, each individuals etc...
