


Figure 1. Homepage of the RE-GRAD Project Website




Figure 2. Homepage of the Consortium section on the RE-GRAD Project Website

- **♣ WP7: Project Management** Overseeing the overall project flow.




Figure 3. Homepage of the WP section on the RE-GRAD Project Website




Figure 4. Homepage of the Outcomes section on the RE-GRAD project Website




Figure 8. Homepage of the Contact Us section on the RE-GRAD project website
